



Memorial Health Diaper Derby Official Rules and Regulations 2019

The Memorial Health Diaper Derby promotion is offered only at designated Stephen F. Austin State University Lumberjack home basketball games in Nacogdoches, Texas. Applications for the Memorial Health Diaper Derby will only be accepted from area residents who are 18 years or older and entering with **a child born at Nacogdoches Memorial Hospital between Oct. 1, 2017 and Oct. 1, 2018**. The Memorial Health Diaper Derby contest qualifying heats will be held on center court during halftime as entertainment for attendees of SFA Lumberjack games on 1) Saturday, Feb. 9 @ 4:30 p.m. and 2) Saturday, Feb. 23 @ 4:30 p.m. Top three finishers in each qualifying heat will have a chance to compete in the final championship round Saturday, March 9, 2018 between the women's and men's basketball games against Sam Houston, at approximately 3:30 p.m.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE: If you think your cutie has what it takes, video your baby crawling and submit that video clip by email to bartonk@nacmem.org, or as a message to the Nacogdoches Memorial Health Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/nacmem>) by **three business days prior to the qualifying round**. You'll also need to fill out the entry form <https://www.nacmem.org/documents/diaperderby.pdf> and submit it by noon three business days prior to the qualifying round (Feb. 6 for the Feb. 9 round and Feb. 20 for the Feb. 23 round). A copy or photo of the child's Nacogdoches Memorial Health birth certificate or official State of Texas birth certificate is required as part of the application and will be validated against patient records.

Guidelines for the participants:

- Eligible babies must have been born at Nacogdoches Memorial Hospital between Oct. 1, 2017 and Oct. 1, 2018. Participants will be required to produce a copy of a Nacogdoches Memorial Health birth certificate or official State of Texas birth certificate.
- Race course will extend from the free throw line or the three point line to half court, a distance of no more than approximately 42 feet.
- Babies cannot be walkers. A baby who walks to a win will be disqualified.
- Babies dressed in costume, Lumberjack apparel or SFA purple will be adored, but won't be favored in the judging.
- Two escort/coaches will be permitted on court & may use objects (toys, keys, bottles, etc.) to encourage babies along the course.
- Coaches should not actually touch the baby until they have crawled across the finish line, unless removing them from the race.
- If at any point your baby becomes uncomfortable in the situation (crying, refusal to move, etc.), feel free to remove baby from race.
- A baby can only win or place in one qualifying round. A baby who does not win or place is welcome to enter any subsequent qualifying round.
- The Memorial Health Diaper Derby is not intended to be a life-altering trauma for our racers . . . or our coaches! Please maintain a spirit of fun and good sportsmanship.
- The well-being of all baby racers will be the top priority of all involved in the Memorial Health Diaper Derby.

PRIZES:

All participants will receive:

- a size 18-month SFA t-shirt courtesy of the university.

Three finalists from each heat will receive:

- a voucher for a case of diapers and a case of formula from Nacogdoches Memorial Hospital.
- a chance to compete in the final round of the Memorial Health Diaper Derby on March 9, 2019.

- four complimentary tickets to the Ladyjack/Lumberjack games against the Sam Houston State Bearcats on March 9, 2019. The championship will be played between the women's and men's games. Contestants will need to report to the coliseum at 3:30 p.m.

The Memorial Health Diaper Derby Champion will crawl away with:

- the grand prize gift pack TBD,
- the priceless recognition of being the 2019 Memorial Diaper Derby Champion!

No prize transfer. No prize substitution or cash equivalent except at the sole discretion of Nacogdoches Memorial Health due to prize unavailability for any reason and only then for a prize of equal value.

ODDS OF WINNING: Odds of being selected as a finalist will be determined by total number of individuals selected by Nacogdoches Memorial Health.
